

For UK & EU nationals

Any 1 of...

- A UK (current or expired) passport showing the holder is a British citizen.
- A passport showing the holder is a citizen of a UK colony and has the right of abode in the UK.
- An EU passport or National Identity Card (current or expired).
- A Permanent Residence Document showing the holder has permanent leave to remain.
- A **non-expired** Biometric Immigration Document showing the holder has permanent leave to remain.
- Travel Documents to show the holder is exempt from immigration control.
- Home Office Immigration Documents to show the holder is permitted to stay in the UK.

List A. Group 1.

or, any 2 of...

- A **full** birth or adoption certificate issued in the UK, Channel Islands, Isle of Man or Ireland.
- A letter issued by a UK-Government department confirming the holder's name, **AND** signed by a named official.
- A letter from a UK Police force.
- HM Forces ID.
- A HM Prisons release letter.
- A letter from a UK university confirming the holder's acceptance on to a course.
- A **current** full or provisional UK driving licence.
- A current UK firearms or shotgun certificate.
- A Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS/CRB) certificate issued **within the last 3 months**.
- Benefits paperwork issued by HMRC, a Local Authority, DWP (inc. Job Centre Plus) dated **within the last 3 months**.

List A. Group 2.

For non-UK/EU nationals, and UK/EU nationals who cannot provide the above

Any 1 of...

- A **non-expired** non-UK/non-EU passport with **non-expired** UK entry visa that is valid until at least the end of the Tenancy.
- A **non-expired** Biometric Immigration Document showing the holder has temporary leave to remain in the UK.
- A **non-expired** Residence Card issued by the Home Office to a non-EU national who has an EU national as a family member.
- A **non-expired** Immigration Document issued by the Home Office showing the holder has leave to remain in the UK for a limited time.
- A **"Yes"** response from the Home Office Landlord's Checking Service.
