WORCESTER TRADITIONAL BREEDS PEAK AT 2,100GNS.

Quality entries of Beef Shorthorns, British Whites and White Parks sharing the day with a strong Longhorn entry proved a resounding success for all breeds and a strong company of buyers from across the country underlying the favourable location of Worcester Market with perfect road communication across the country.

Beef Shorthorns topped at a very creditable 2,100gns for “Greenley Rosette Honey”, a maiden heifer by “Lucombe Duke” and part of a superb consignment from Towers and Heard, Northampton and secured by G. Armstrong, Naseby, Leics. The Greenley entry enjoyed a strong following with other maiden heifers selling at 1,500gns, 1,450gns, 1,300gns, 1,200gns, all taken by E.C. Haste, Beaworthy, Devon. A smart entry of cows and calves from Robert Leach, Banbury found favour with buyers selling at 1,580gns twice and 1,380gns, all to ATF Brodie & Son, Worcester.

British Whites hit the four figure mark twice for Cows in calf – Paul Pennington’s “Latchygors Tealeaf” making 1,000gns to CA Simons, Inkberrow, Worcs and Rob Turner’s “Ty Carreg Leprechaun” to N.Bowen, Hereford. Maiden Heifers sold to 690gns for “Oldington Teatree” from P. Pennington.

White Park Cattle were well in the frame and peaked at 1,400gns for David Graveston’s “Pennyspot Phoebe” a 6 year old cow with bull calf and also the pre sale Champion, taken by R. Loxam, Lancaster. The Reserve Champion “Beaudesert Jasmine” an in calf cow from DW Cope & Partners levelled at 1,100gns to RG Murray & Co., Grafton Flyford, Worcs. Served Heifers topped at 950gns from J & J Byrne-Daniel for “Pantygwyn Siskin” to R Critchlow, Buxton, Derby.
