STORE CATTLE – 772

More buyers present as the autumn season gets into full swing. As reports around the weather, buyers concerned about the fodder stocks and are being selective. The majority of cattle on offer found new homes.

FEEDING COWS (OTMS)

More feeding cows needed, several buyers looking for these to feed. If you have cows that will stand more feeding please use this section.

FEEDING BULLS

A solid trade with more buyers present. Young well bred sucklers being the most sought after. The entry included several older types and dairy sorts. Bulls topped at £1120pph or £2.79ppk to average £800pph or £2.10ppk. More bulls needed for the next sale.

FEEDING HEIFERS

Good strong types and suckled sorts relatively easy to sell. Natives and cattle showing the effects of the dry summer would be more challenging. Having said this there were buyers looking. Please do not let cattle sink and lose their flesh. Cattle that had had dry food had a premium. Heifers topped at £1140pph or £2.45ppk to average £775pph of £1.80ppk.

STEERS

A good lot of steers forward. Several groups were showing of the effects of the summer and lost their loins. With feed costs as they are, buyers were looking for warmer and easy feeders. Steers made $\pounds 1125pph$ or $\pounds 2.49ppk$ to average $\pounds 855pph$ or $\pounds 1.91ppk$.

BREEDING EWES

The breeding ewes on offer were an end of season entry. Trade was very selective. Some stronger Texel X yearling ewes reached £122. A feature of the sale was some Welsh ewes of flock ages which made up to \pounds 73 and averaged \pounds 56.60.

There was a good entry of ewe lambs. The prize winners in the show classes were:

Top price of the day was for a pen of pure bred Texel ewe lambs which made $\pounds 118$. Other purebred Texel lambs made $\pounds 100$. Overall average for all ewe lambs sold $\pounds 77.84$ with an 80% clearance rate. Texel ram lambs to $\pounds 304$.

CALVES & WEANLINGS – 5

A small entry of calves sold to a good trade with good buying support. There was a good entry of breeds to include; Friesian X, Hereford X, Angus and British Blue X.
