PRE- MOVEMENT T.B. TESTING

<u>As from 1st March 2007 all cattle aged 42 days and over</u> are required to be T.B. Tested (and be negative) within 60 <u>days</u> of proposed movement if they are destined for further finishing (i.e. Store cattle at "Green Markets") provided you are in a parish of 1 or 2 years testing. If less frequent than this do not worry!

FINISHED CATTLE/OTM CATTLE at "Red Markets" (every Wednesday) there is no requirement for testing

FABBL – IMPORTANT

Even though you are selling Store Cattle, Buyers are very anxious that cattle MUST BE FARM ASSURED. Please make every effort to get FABBL – it will be worthwhile.

A strong yard of hoggets for the time of year sold to a very sound trade, especially considering the uncertainty regarding the fat trade. Still plenty of men looking to buy Hoggs to go on and finish and this has led to plenty of competition from the first to the last pen. Even with some smaller, poorer bred sorts we finished with an overall average of \pounds 60.92 with Tup Hoggs averaging \pounds 67.81

IN LAMB EWES: 211

A good entry of In Lamb Ewes sold to a solid trade with plenty of competition throughout. Some large entries of NCM & Welsh Mules present sold up to £94 with an overall average of £82
