BRECON MARKET STORE CATTLE REPORT Friday 22nd February 2019

Store Cattle 608

The fat trade has fallen since January, however stores at Brecon were significantly up on last month with steers averaging 221p/kg and \pm 1040/head for a yard of smaller types while heifers were 216p/kg and an incredible \pm 986/head for all types.

The recent weather and a general shortage of cattle fuelled the trade, but producers should note more buyers are coming to Brecon every month due to the quality, quantity and the reputation of Brecon for genuine home bred cattle.

We have the capacity and demand for 1000 cattle every month – more are urgently required and new vendors are welcome.

We had a wonderful entry of quality types from noted breeders, such as Jones, Bailea Farm who made ± 1680 of a smart young limousin x steer while JAV Mills, Llanerchllwyd had an exceptionally large entry of young cattle which topped at ± 1550 for his steers. Also, Messrs Cooke of Nantyderi Farm had a wonderful entry of strong heifers which attracted several men looking for breeding heifers which has become a feature at Brecon, and he had 3 over ± 1520 , topping at ± 1570 all of which went to a new buyer AJ Neachell from Walsall.

The sale was a great success considering the fat trade is under pressure and all vendors were encouraged by the demand and confidence around the ring.

A disappointing entry met with a fantastic trade which was on average \pounds 50- \pounds 60 up on last month and certainly 10-15p/kg.

A top price of $\pounds 1320$ was reached, however all those mid-range types, well meated and farm assured certainly benefitted from a jump in the trade and a strong premium for the right types.

The overall average was an impressive 140.5p/kg and an average of £987/head.

We had 9 genuine buyers for all types from lean feeding cows to over fat types, however we desperately need more cows to maintain this excellent trade at Brecon every month.

400 PRIME LAMBS

A slightly smaller entry of prime Hoggetts in terms of numbers but again of similar general quality to the entry of last week with quality at the higher end of the spectrum. The trade and average was almost identical to last week and again better than that seen in Friday and Saturday sale centres and up on the Monday National Average. There was however a distinct premium for the best end of the Hoggs within the desired weight spectrum and the top selling was as fast as last week. It is again reiterated that we need a larger weekly entry to meet buyer demand with the number forward today not sufficient for our valued customer base to get full loads. Follow our predictions through the week via social media and the website and we hope for another fast trade and a larger entry next week. The SQQ average of $\pounds 1.90$ ppk and the overall average of $\pounds 1.88$ ppk was boosted by the general quality forward.

Note - Farm Assurance is important and the girls in the office require the 'Green Forms' to be filled out and signed with consignments.
